Overview

Global Partners MBA is a transformative 14-month, four-continent, dual-degree program designed to create the next generation of global business leaders. Students learn firsthand through intense coursework, cultural immersion and face-to-face meetings with top executives worldwide. This experience, combined with a four-month internship, offers unique insight into conducting business in today's global marketplace.

Graduates receive two degrees and a certificate:

- MBA from Georgia State's Robinson College of Business (USA)
- Master d'Administration des Entreprises (MBA) from IAE de Paris, Sorbonne Graduate Business School (France)
- Certificate in Global Business Management from COPPEAD, the Graduate Business School of the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro (Brazil)

This program enrolls in the fall semester only.

Structure, Schedule and Location

Global Partners MBA is unique. It takes students to four continents for classes in Atlanta, Paris and Rio de Janeiro, as well as commercial diplomacy and business field studies in Washington, D.C.; Brussels and three cities in China. The program culminates with an international internship in the city of your choice. The program lasts **14 months** and confers **two degrees**.

Candidate Profile

Candidates must hold a four-year undergraduate degree from an accredited college or university. The average candidate has five years of professional experience, has traveled internationally, and speaks or has studied a second language.

Tuition and Fees

Tuition is **\$72,000** and includes tuition for all three universities; books; iPad; airfare to Washington D.C., Paris, Rio de Janeiro and China; ground transportation to Brussels; travel to and from class in Rio de Janeiro; travel to company visits; inter-country travel in China; hotels in Washington, D.C.; Brussels and China; tea and coffee breaks; catered student events and an exclusive graduation reception.
