Areas of need include financial, managerial, auditing, tax, and accounting information systems. Rank is open but we expect to hire at the level of Clinical Assistant Professor (preferred) or Lecturer. Candidates for Clinical Assistant Professor must have demonstrated high-level classroom performance, significant professional experience, the capability for publishing research in refereed journals, and a doctorate in Accounting (or related field) from an AACSB-accredited university or, for teaching tax, a JD and graduate degree in tax/accounting. Candidates for Lecturer must have demonstrated high-level classroom performance, significant professional experience, and at minimum a master's degree in accounting (or related field) from an AACSB-accredited university. Salaries are competitive with significant opportunity for other teaching compensation. Positions are contingent on budget approval.
