The Robinson College of Business seeks applications and nominations for a tenure track Assistant Professor in the area of Human Resource Management /Organizational Behavior. The successful candidate will be someone who can contribute to our existing strength in research in Human Resource Management/Organization Behavior and should be focused on micro-HRM/OB issues. This position offers an exceptional opportunity to qualified candidates due to a combination of unique and attractive resources. The Department of Managerial Sciences is fortunate to have many outstanding faculty colleagues with interests in Human Resource Management and Organization Behavior and is closely affiliated with the Beebe Institute of Personnel and Employment Relations. In addition, our faculty members have engaged with colleagues in other units of the College, the University, and neighboring universities in the Atlanta area in a variety of professional activities to form an engaged community of scholars. The successful candidate will begin employment in August, 2012.

The position includes teaching at the graduate and/or undergraduate levels in the College's academic programs. Salary, teaching loads, and other types of support are competitive with other research universities. This position is contingent upon final budget approval by the University.
