CROSS-LEVEL REGISTRATION POLICY

- Beginning Summer 2017, Atlanta campus students may take a maximum of **four** Perimeter College courses during their academic career. These courses may be taken during summer semester(s) only, provided they (1) satisfy all prerequisites for the courses, (2) have **completed** 12 credit hours at the Atlanta campus, and (3) have a minimum 2.0 institutional GPA.
- Any linked or co-requisite courses will count as one course (i.e. ASTR 1010 and ASTR 1010L; MATH 0999 and MATH 1111).
- Summer courses taken at a Perimeter College campus by Atlanta campus students will have the same impact on a student’s institutional GPA as courses taken at the Atlanta campus.
- Summer courses taken at a Perimeter College campus by Atlanta campus students may be used to satisfy the repeat to replace policy and must follow all policy requirements listed in the catalog. (Section 1350.25)
- Summer courses taken at Perimeter College campus by Atlanta campus students count as grade attempts for all Bachelor level degree policies (including the withdrawal policy).
- Georgia State University will allow no more than 12 semester hours of D grades to apply toward degree requirements of a baccalaureate program of study. These 12 semester hours include both credit completed at Georgia State (resident credit), cross-level credit, and transfer credit.
- If taking courses at both Perimeter Campus and Atlanta Campus during summer semester, tuition will be assessed based on the campus location for each course (Perimeter, Perimeter Online, or Atlanta).
