As director of tax accounting and reporting at United Parcel Service, Aaron Konnick is responsible for preparing all income tax disclosures included in the company's publicly filed financial statements and investor communications. In addition, Konnick leads the team responsible for preparation of all U.S. federal income tax returns, supplemental filings, and quarterly estimated tax payments. Finally, Konnick is responsible for monitoring and modeling the financial impact of global tax legislation and communicating the expected impact to the CFO, CAO, treasurer, and others on the UPS Management Committee. He joined UPS in 2015 and has been in his current role since 2017.

Prior to joining UPS, Konnick was a director in the tax practice of PwC, one of the largest professional services firms in the world. During his 10 years at PwC, Konnick served as an advisor to many of the largest businesses and private equity firms in the world, providing services including tax provision preparation and auditing, tax return preparation, and international tax planning.

Konnick holds a B.B.A. and MAcc from the University of Georgia as well as a certificate in personal and organizational leadership from the UGA Institute for Leadership Advancement. He is a CPA licensed in Georgia, where he has worked in the tax profession since 2005. Konnick is an instructor at Georgia State University and guest lecturer in various accounting, tax, and leadership courses at Georgia State University, University of Georgia, and various professional organizations.
