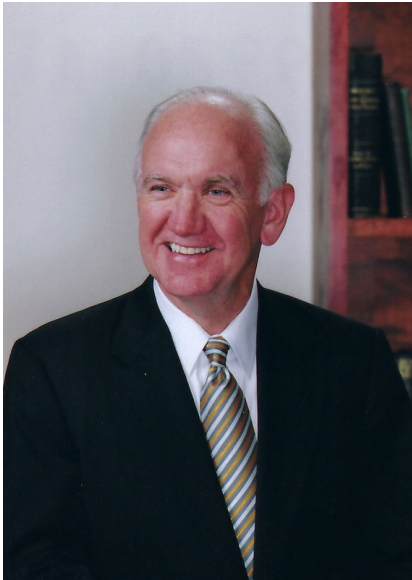


Harold D. Skipper International Insurance Endowment

Skipper International Insurance Endowment is a fitting tribute to a man whose career as a scholar, leader, teacher, and ambassador has left a lasting impact on GSU and on international insurance.

About Dr. Harold D. Skipper



A world renowned scholar and author, Dr. Skipper's focus has been on insurance-related public policy issues, particularly those related to supervision, taxation and international trade. His work played an important role in the World Trade Organization's General Agreement on Trade in Services (GATS). He is a leading co-author of textbooks on international insurance and was the co-author of the 15th Edition of *Life Insurance*, Solomon S. Huebner's seminal insurance textbook originally published in 1915.

Dr. Skipper has been a visiting professor at the University of Paris and at Nanyang Technological University in Singapore. He has served on advisory boards for the Center for Social Security and Insurance Research at Peking University, the Center for Insurance Research at the Indian Institute of Management in Bangalore, and the Singapore College of Insurance.

He served a three-year appointment as Economics Affairs Officer with the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development in Geneva. He worked with Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development,

the World Bank, the U. S. Department of Commerce, and the National Association of Insurance Commissioners.

He is past President of American Risk and Insurance Association, past Vice President of the International Insurance Society, and was a moving force behind the creation of the Asia-Pacific Risk and Insurance Association.

He received his undergraduate from Georgia State University and graduate degrees and Ph. D. from the University of Pennsylvania where he was a Huebner Fellow.

About the Harold D. Skipper International Insurance Endowment

Since Dr. Skipper retired in 2005, GSU's RMI Department has continued to have an international profile, with academic programs that attract students from across the globe and faculty that conduct research on international risk and insurance topics. The endowment would be used to fund scholarships and recruiting trips to attract talented international students from developing countries. These efforts will support the dissemination of insurance knowledge worldwide when many of these students return to their home countries with the risk management and insurance knowledge they acquired at GSU. The endowment will also support research on risk and insurance topics critical for improving economic outcomes in developing economies.
